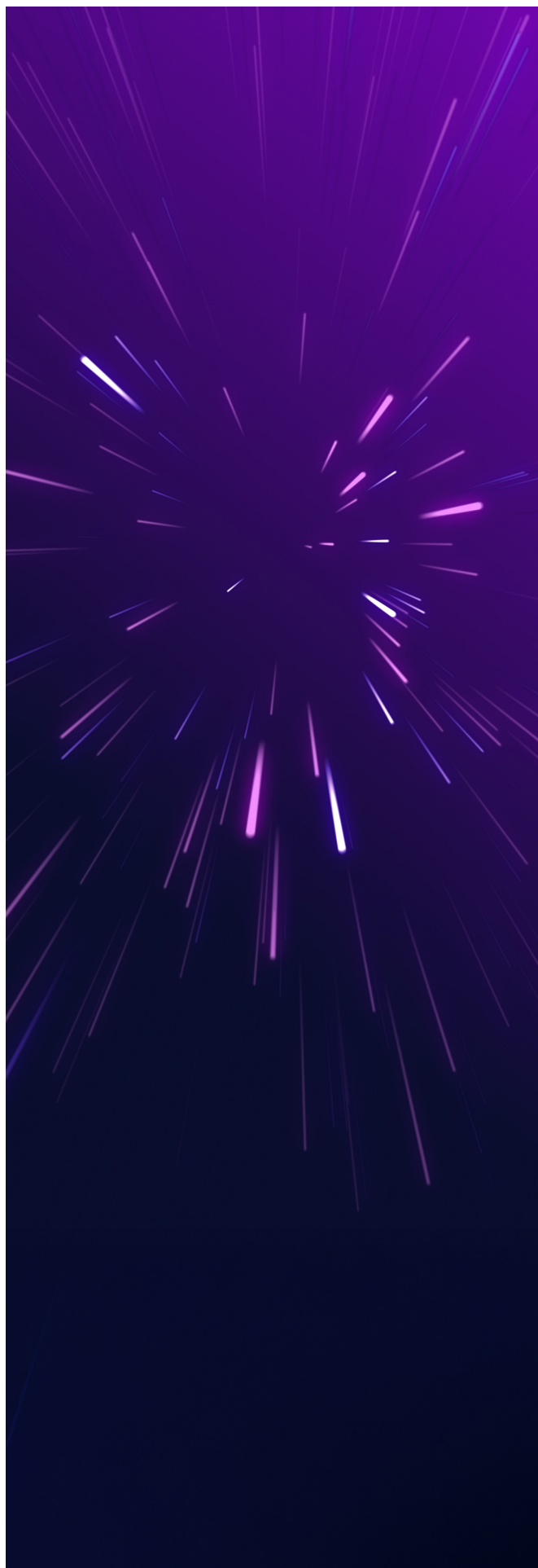

? What is the Command340B suite?

Built to scale with program needs, Command340B supports each phase of the current 340B lifecycle, from real-time data integration to Beacon (and any future rebate platforms), submissions, savings transparency, and rebate model strategy.
